PARAMUS Lewis Wright Dunham, 89, formerly of Glen Rock, died on Aug. 18.

He was born in Binghamton, N.Y. and resided in Glen Rock for 54 years before moving to Paramus. He was a 1938 graduate of Binghamton Central High School, and then he went on to serve three years in the United States Army Air Corps during World War II. He then went on to work for New York Telephone Company, retiring as a company executive. He was a founder and charter member of the Glen Rock Activities Club, lifetime member of the Minisceongo Yacht Club, where he served as the Commodore in 1975, life member of the Telephone Pioneers and a board of director of Community Meals.


He is survived by his nephews and niece, Robert Bamhart and wife Susan of Glastonbury, Conn., Kathy Miller of White Plains, N.Y. and Rodney Wulff of Sykeville, Md; his great-nieces, Lauren and Kara Bamhart; and his relatives in the Binghamton area. He was predeceased by his wife, Ruth (nee Pfeiffer).

A memorial service was held on Aug. 21 at the Browning-Forshay Funeral Home in Hawthorne. Cremation was private.
