He was a life member of Edwards Weavers Post 7290 VFW, North Syracuse, and was a longtime member of James Harvey Spire American Legion Post 787, Cicero. For 34 years he was a member of the B.P.O. Elks Lodge No. 2348 and bowled for many years with several leagues. In the 1990s he retired from New York Telephone, where he had been a lineman, and was a life member of the Telephone Pioneers of America. Beverly J. Davies Dunham, his wife of 48 years, predeceased him on November 6, 2001. Surviving are his children, Donald J.
